Assignment:

Read a book from the approved list (or have an alternative approved by Mr. Millhouse) and complete the attached sheets. Student must complete all parts of assignment. No partial credit will be given.

PART B

Choose a theme (or part of a theme) from the World History AP themes listed in your syllabus (syllabus is on my website) that relates to the book. Answer the prompt below in a traditional five paragraph essay. Make sure you include at least 15 pieces of factual evidence from the book to answer the prompt.

Analyze how the author’s use of your chosen theme added to your understanding of world history.

Format for essay:

- Must be typed (times new roman, 12 pt font, double spaced, 1 inch margins)
- Should be *between* 2-3 pages in length
- Essay must have in-text citations. Use Chicago (or Turabian) style. See link on my website for help.
- Works cited and/or bibliography is not necessary
- No credit will be awarded for any essay where there is suspicion of plagiarism or cheating.
